- 1. Our reputation for integrity starts with good **governance**:
 - Timely, quality, publicly available agenda, minutes, and accounts.
 - Responsible stewardship of funds and assets.
- 2. We will be <u>representative</u> of, and accountable to, all members of our community.
 - Our membership should reflect the demographics of the community.
 - We will take steps to keep residents informed of our activities.
 - We will be easily contactable. We will give timely responses to correspondence.
 - Wherever possible we will use data to back up our representations.
- 3. We will grow our **influence** in the following ways:
 - We will act with integrity in our dealings with residents and other agencies: we will keep commitments, saying what we mean and meaning what we say.
 - We will build co-operative, trusting relationships within the community and with other agencies.
 - We will take pro-active steps on the issues that matter most to local people, including projects and campaigns.
 - We will develop our personal skills and knowledge.
